



What are we learning in Lusty Glaze and Polzeath this term? Summer Term

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back after the Easter holidays, I hope you have all had a good break with your families and enjoyed celebrating Easter.

This half term our curriculum topic is:

Are you a survivor?

The majority of the work that we do during the first part of the Summer Term will link to our Geography topic: Are you a survivor?

We will be finding out about rivers, volcanoes and mountains and investigating how we could survive a night in these places. We will learn about what we would need to help us survive in the different environments.

Our Art and Design projects will involve painting landscape water colour pictures in the style of Turner. We will also spend some time in the forest area learning about how to make effective dens suitable for survival.

During literacy we will be studying a fiction book called The Storm we will then be moving onto a non-fiction book based on the history of Tutankhamun next half term.

Our Science focus for this term will be Animals including Humans. We will be learning more about the body and have a focus on food and healthy eating. We will also carry out a number of investigations and experiments.

Next half term our Curriculum topic is:

Was Tutankhamun killed?

The majority of the work that we do during the first part of the Summer Term will link to our History topic: Was Tutankhamun killed?

In this unit the children will investigate whether or not Tutankhamun was killed. They will be looking at evidence to support their theories. They will finally write a detailed response using all of their research to answer the big question.

In History we will be looking into the life of Tutankhamun and use primary and secondary sources associated with everything to do with his life and death.

It is going to be a packed term with events such as sports day and end of term days out and we will be trying to make the most of outside lessons during the nice weather.
